5. The reporting person has sole voting and dispositive power with respect to such shares in his capacity as manager of Schuler Grandchildren LLC.

6. The reporting person has shared voting and dispositive power with respect to such shares in his capacity as the grantor of Schuler GC 2010 Continuation Trust.
